

Full privacy notice-contractors

Type of personal data processed and purpose

DJM Estates will process details of your company, including your personal details if you are a sole trader or small partnership, in order to fulfil a contract for you to provide a service. This service could be directly to DJM Estates or to a customer (landlord, tenant, vendor or buyer) for whom DJM Estates acts as agent. Your personal information may include your name, address, email address and telephone number, as well as bank details.

Legal basis and retention

The legal basis for processing your details is to fulfil a contract.

We will retain your personal information for current year plus six for financial purposes.

Information sharing

Your information will be routinely shared with:

As an agent, DJM Estates may receive ad hoc enquiries, such as from local authority housing sections and police, but will not share your information with third parties without your consent, unless DJM Estates is required to do so by law.

Your rights

Under data protection law, you have the following rights:

2. The right of access
3. The right to rectification
4. The right to erasure
5. The right to restrict processing
6. The right to data portability
7. The right to object
8. Rights in relation to automated decision making and profiling.
